She has participated in several festivals, among others the Festival Leo Brouwer, Festival de Música Antigua Esteban Salas, Festival Septiembre Barroco, Festival de Música Contemporánea de La Habana, Festival Mozart en La Habana. In 2005, she was awarded the medal of honour of her hometown Holguín.

She has **performed** in the **most important concert halls** in Cuba and is a and is a member of the 'Sociedad de Músicade Cámara de La Habana'. As a guest musician she has worked with the ensemble for early musicmusic ensemble 'Ars Longa' and with various symphony orchestras in Cuba.

In Europe, her concert career has taken her to the **Bach Festival** in **Budapest** in 2023 as a **soloist**.

She is currently studying **recorder** with Claudia Gerauer at the Regensburg University of Catholic Church Music and Music Education (HfKM Regensburg) in the Master. She received further musical impulses at **masterclasses** with Kees Boeke, Michael Oman and Jana Semerádová.
